Professional Experience

Dave Tuggle has a Ph.D. in Anthropology from the University of Arizona. He has worked in Hawai'i and the Pacific for 40 years. In Hawai'i, Dave Tuggle has carried out field and archival research on seven of the eight main islands. These projects have variously involved inventory, survey, excavation, and interpretive planning. All projects have included extensive background research in archives and other historical records of

Hawai‘i, and many have included work with native Hawaiian individuals and organizations. He has written numerous reports, articles, and reviews concerning the archaeology and pre-Contact history of Hawai‘i, and has been a member of many organizations in Hawai‘i, including the Hawai‘i Historic Places Review Board. Other places in the Pacific where he has carried out archaeological research include Palau, Guam, Saipan, Tinian, the Philippines, and Japan. He has also conducted archaeological investigation in Arizona, New York, and Mexico.
