Archaeology: Over 30 years of experience in Hawaiian archaeology, working on a range of research and compliance-related projects on all major islands except Ni'ihau; as an independent contractor, conceived and directed large-scale surveys of the Na Pali coast on the island of Kaua'i and the district of North Kohala on the island of Hawai'i. Has also worked in the American Southwest, Guam, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands since 1991.

History: Since 1979, has directed professional interests toward integrating historical research with archaeological investigations; major projects include research (archaeological survey, archival research, and oral history interviews) on the district of North Kohala and in extensive land areas of North and South Kona on the island of Hawai'i; has carried out intensive historical projects for military installations on O'ahu and Hawai'i.

Cultural Resource Management (CRM) Planning: Translates experience in community and resource planning to archaeological-historical investigations; projects for private sector, local government, and military clients address a range of planning issues related to resort development, integrating resource management with military missions, and conception of regional parks; major projects include developing cultural resource management plans for Army, Navy, and Air Force installations in Hawai'i and Micronesia.
