Professional Experience

Archaeology: Over 35 years of experience in Hawaiian archaeology, working on a range of research and compliance-related projects on all major islands except Ni'ihau. As an independent contractor, Ms. Tuggle conceived and directed large-scale surveys of the Na Pali coast on the island of Kaua'i and the district of North Kohala on the island of Hawai'i. With IARII, she has also directed or worked on projects in Hawai'i, the Territory of Guam, the Republic of Palau, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

Historical Research: Integrates historical research with archaeological investigations. Major projects include research (archaeological survey, archival research, and oral history interviews) on the district of North Kohala and in extensive land areas of North and South Kona on the island of Hawai'i, including projects for the National Park Service on Hawai'i Island and Maui, and for military installations in Hawai'i and Okinawa. She has conducted documentary research in the local archives and record repositories in Hawai'i, as well as at the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) in College Park, Maryland, and San Bruno, California, and the Air Force Historical Research Center at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama.



Cultural Resource Management (CRM) Planning: Translates experience in community and resource planning to archaeological-historical investigations. Ms. Tuggle has carried out projects for private sector, local government, and federal and military clients that address a range of planning issues related to resort development, integration of resource management with military missions, and conception of regional parks. Major projects include developing cultural resource management plans for military installations in Hawai‘i, Micronesia, Japan, and Korea.

As a planner with the Department of Hawaiian Homelands (Hawai‘i) from 1983 to 1984 and the City of Tucson (Arizona) from 1986 to 1989, Ms. Tuggle acquired a thorough background in land use policy planning and community interaction which she now applies to historic preservation concerns. Her planning experience includes proposal writing, review of land use permitting applications, coordinating and leading community meetings, making public presentations, and acting as liaison between public and private agencies.

Interpretive Planning: Expands on CRM focus to bring archaeological and historical inquiry to the general public. Ms. Tuggle has developed public presentations of archaeological and historical interest, prepared interpretive concept plans, and has used her graphic arts and writing capabilities in developing public interest books, brochures, and trailside interpretive signage in Hawai‘i, Micronesia, Japan, and Arizona. In doing this work, she has written and edited text, prepared illustrations, designed sign and book layouts, and coordinated with fabricators for final production.
